SummaCare and Summa Health System have implemented a Physician House Calls program. A dedicated team led by a geriatrician will provide clinical care to SummaCare Secure and traditional Medicare (non-HMO) patients who meet the specific criteria. Patients who meet the criteria and choose to enroll in the program will then become a patient of a geriatrician and the House Calls team. Following an initial visit by a geriatrician the patient will be seen by the nurse practitioner and social worker.

Patient Criteria

- SummaCare Secure member
- Traditional Medicare enrollee
- Lives in Summit County
- Age 65+ (exceptions made on a case by case basis)
- Physical disability that makes going to a doctor's office difficult
- Diagnosed with any of the following conditions:
 - Hypertension
 - Heart failure
 - COPD
 - Diabetes
 - Bacterial pneumonia
