

# Coaches First Aid / PAV Consortium

## ALL Coaches Attend for only \$200/school

**Goal:** Decreased expense to the schools and the coaches; convenience for the coaches and athletic directors; guaranteed quality program and educational experience

**Each consortium school receives:**

- Availability of coaches and volunteers to attend any of the PAV/Coaches First Aid for FREE that are run by Summa Center for Sports Health
- Athletic Directors will receive a roster of all of their coaches that attended after each class
- Each coach will receive an educational packet to use as a reference with educational handouts for them and their athletes/parents

**When will the classes be held:**

- Periodically throughout the school year
- July
- Sept/Oct
- Jan/Feb

**Where:** Akron City Hospital, as well as various schools around Summit and Portage Counties.

**Cost:** \$200 per school; Checks payable to Summa Health System

**How do coaches register:**

1. Flyers will be sent via email to all of the AD's at the participating schools that will list out all the dates, times and locations
2. Coaches can either fill out the registration and mail it in, or call Summa Connections to register
3. Coaches will just have to give them their name, school, SS# at the time of registration
4. Check – in at the door the day of and pick up the information at the conclusion that has all of the information they need to submit their PAV Permit Application on-line with the ODE
