Summa Akron City Hospital Emergency Department Phase I Fact Sheet

Construction timeline:

- Groundbreaking: April 27, 2010
- Phase I open to patients: January 19, 2012 after 22 months of construction
- Phase II open for patients: June 2012

Size:

- Current facility: 19,000 square feet and 43 beds
- Phase I: 85,000 square feet, 44 beds and 10 triage rooms
- Phase II: 21,000 square feet, 32 beds
- The Ambulance Bay is 9,100 square feet and includes a partially underground and enclosed turnaround space with heated concrete and ambient heat. Up to 12 ambulances can fit in the bay at one time. It is believed to be one of only few with this unique design in the country.

Location:

 Summa Akron City Hospital, 525 E. Market St., Akron, Ohio Drive-up patient entrance via N. Forge St.

Patient volume:

- Nearly 79,000 patients treated in 2011. More than 82,000 expected in 2012.
- 1,300 ambulance squads arrive monthly
- About 60 patients admitted to the hospital for overnight care each day

Accreditations:

- Level I Trauma Center, the highest trauma verification
- Certified Chest Pain Center
- Certified Stroke Center
- Serves as the tertiary transfer center for all Summa facilities
- Phase II of the project will include a Geriatric Emergency Department specially designed to treat the area's growing senior population.

Building:

- \$49 million total for Phase I and Phase II
