Additional information available in MyChart

As you know, MyChart is a valuable tool that allows you to access your health information 24/7, at home and on the go. As of October 20, 2020, we have expanded the information available in your account. These changes will help you be a partner in your care.

What You Can Expect:

- You'll get lab and test results as soon as they are available. Your provider receives this information at the same time, so it's possible that you may see these results before your provider has reviewed them.
- Your provider may talk with you at the time of ordering imaging or lab tests to provide additional information on what you may expect when you receive the results in MyChart.
- For common lab tests, additional information will be added to MyChart to help you understand how your results compare to normal ranges. You can expect your provider to reach out directly to you about your results if there are any concerns.
- Notes from your visits will be available.
- You may notice an increase in email notifications about information being added to your MyChart account. You can update your communication preferences at any time to choose what type and frequency of notifications. To change your communication preferences, log in to MyChart, click on "Profile," under Preferences & Info, click on "Communications."
