## **General Policies**

- The Children's Corner is a "drop-in" facility for children 6 weeks-12 years old. Although childcare ratios are not required like they are in a "daycare" facility where children stay all day, we try to comply with the state recommended staffing ratios.
- As a "drop-in" facility:
  - o Parents must remain on site.
  - We are not permitted to feed children or change diapers.
- Children can stay for up to 90 minutes per day. This includes morning/evening hours combined.
- Changes cannot be made to autopay mid-month. Adding/dropping children will be effective the beginning of the next month.
- Children will be permitted to bring water bottles and sippy cups and must be labeled with child's name. Food is not permitted.
- You can only drop off your child or grandchild. If someone other than the person who dropped off the child will be picking the child up, the staff must be notified and the name of the person picking up the child must be given. We reserve the right to ask for appropriate identification.
- Toys are provided. If a child insists on bringing in a toy from home, please note that we are not responsible for any lost, stolen or broken toys.
- Parents will be notified of any disciplinary problems the staff is having with a child. Continuous insubordination may result in a temporary suspension from the Children's Corner.

## Illness policies

- We ask that you do not bring your children in when they are sick. If your child is too ill to attend school, he/she is too ill to visit Children's Corner. We reserve the right to refuse childcare due to illness.
- A temporary exclusion is required when the child appears to be severely ill, has a fever of 100°F or above, diarrhea, vomiting, Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye), when the illness prevents the child from participating comfortably in activities as determined by staff, and/or the child requires more care than staff can give.
- We ask that if your child contracts a contagious illness (e.g. Hand-Foot-Mouth Disease, Lice, Chickenpox), please notify us so we can inform the other members who used the Children's Corner during the same time.
